

FLOWER SHOW RULES

1. Exhibits must be in place by 10:00 AM.
2. LATE entries will NOT be accepted. Judging begins at 10:30 AM.
3. Staging tables are 30" high.
4. Each active member is required to enter at least one floral design or horticulture or photography class each year.
5. To receive points at In-Club Shows, members must register their entries in the ledger provided by the Division Chair before judging begins.
- 6. It is the responsibility of each member to report Out-of-Club Shows to the Statistician by May of every year.**
- 7. It is suggested that exhibitors leave their entries in place as long as possible so that all members may view them.**

Floral Design Guidelines

1. One entry per member per class.
2. Background required in niches. Accessories optional.
3. Fresh plant material required unless otherwise stated.
4. The use of state or federal endangered plants is prohibited.
5. Members may enter the artistic classes individually or as pairs.
6. Novice – Someone who has never won a blue ribbon in Floral Design in a club or outside show.
7. A list of plant material used in an arrangement is required.
8. All completed arrangements must be passed by designated passers. The exhibitor must remain with the exhibit until it has been passed and may not touch the exhibit after it has been passed.
